



AUGUST 21 SOLAR ECLIPSE PARTY

There will be a solar eclipse viewing party on August 21 from 2-3 PM, the best time in which to view the eclipse. Tables will be set up in front of the library with grab bags of snacks available. Please bring your own lawn chair if you would like seating.

Solar eclipse glasses (the only safe way to look at the sun during this event) will be available for those attending the party on a first come, first served basis. A live video feed from NASA of the solar eclipse will be available in the auditorium for those who'd prefer to stay indoors or after we're out of glasses.

The moon will start to eclipse the sun at 12:57 (from the right), will eclipse most of the sun (peak time) at 2:24, and will quit eclipsing the sun at 3:47 (ending on the left of the sun). The party will only be from 2-3; however, you are welcome to stay later if you want to.
