The Library Board of Trustees met to discuss the future goals of the Peru Public Library and possible ideas that could be implemented to meet those future objectives. Ideas included:

- Have some specific goals and steps that are attainable and less vague in our strategic plan.
- More training opportunities and continuing education for the staff.
- Board members speaking to community organizations and businesses to see what their needs are that can be met by the library. Possibly hire a consultant to construct a thorough strategic plan.
- Look into a grant for digitization of newspapers.
- Look into getting genealogy databases.
- Building renovations on more of a scheduled plan.
- Delivery outreach to older shut-in patrons and nursing homes.
- Possibly get a library vehicle for outreach.
- Look into other revenue resources and continue our excellent fiscal management as the government continues to slash funds. Find community partners to help with this endeavor.
- Continue good board dynamics and relationships amongst trustee members. Possibly start nurturing people that could someday come on the board.
- Try to start an active Friends of the Library group.
- Continue to focus on literacy for the youth of Miami County and getting books into the hands of children.
- Look to increase the number of staff employees and staff pay in the future.
- Work of facility, including: outdoor lighting, windows, office space, parking lot, AC unit, space for collection.
- Possibly purchase the building next door to make a library annex.
- How to handle our unhoused population as we move forward in the future.
